Documentation Requirements

All Insurances

- ★ CGM Supplies Prescription
- ★ Medical records (see below for criteria)

Medical Record Requirements

- ★ Face to face visit within 6 months prior to ordering CGM, in which the treating practitioner documents the following:
 - Patient has diabetes mellitus,
 - Patient's current diabetes control and plan,
 - Patient is being prescribed the CGM to improve glycemic control because:
 - Patient is insulin treated, OR
 - Patient has a history of problematic hypoglycemia with documentation of one of the following:
 - More than 2 level 2 hypoglycemic events (glucose <54mg/dL) that persist despite multiple attempts to adjust medication and/or modify the diabetes treatment plan
 - A history of one level 3 hypoglycemic even (glucose <54mg/dL) characterized by altered mental and/or physical state requiring third-party assistance for treatment of hypoglycemia.
- ★ Face to face visit every 6 months after initiation CGM therapy, in which the treating practitioner documents:
 - Patient's adherence to their CGM regimen
 - Compliance with diabetes management plan.
 - These notes MUST be provided to Procure every 6 months to continue dispensing supplies.
