#### **G7 Basics** | G7 shows your glucose information on your display devices.



- During setup, we'll show you how to use the applicator to insert the built-in sensor under your skin
- The sensor sends a glucose reading to your receiver or other display device every 5 minutes
- The sensor lasts up to 10 days with a 12-hour grace period



After you insert the sensor, you must apply the overpatch to keep the sensor on your body.

#### **Receiver setup**

#### 1. Insert sensor

- You must insert your sensor before pairing to the receiver.
- For instructions go to Inserting Sensor in the sensor box.

### 2. Set up receiver

- Press the Select button for 3-5 seconds to turn on receiver. (Go to Receiver navigation.)
- · Follow receiver instructions to set up the receiver. Insert sensor before pairing.
- After inserting and pairing, follow local guidelines for throwing out the applicator and recycling the Dexcom packaging.

## 3. Sensor warmup

Sensor warmup timer tells you when you'll start getting readings and alerts.

The receiver screen tells you which button to use.

- To scroll faster hold down the Scroll button
- To move to next field use the Select button
